**Scholarship policy:** In an effort to make our programs as accessible as possible, PCFE Film School offers two forms of financial aid. The PCFE Scholarship Fund, a highly-competitive fund, provides grants covering up to fifty per cent of tuition for a select few candidates demonstrating unusual potential in the area of film.

The PCFE Grant-Matching Program, on the other hand, provides financial aid to any applicant who succeeds in securing funding for PCFE programs from another official grant-giving institution. The applicant however will be expected to provide a certified copy of the letter from the official grant-giving institution.

To be eligible for consideration for financial aid, all financial aid applicants must complete the essay questions on the application form, demonstrating their creative maturity, experience and interest in film.

- b) Provide a proposal for a short film you would like to produce (it need not be the film you make in Prague). Describe the story line, the cast and other creative elements in the production of the film.

**3. Creative Portfolio (optional but highly recommended):**

Please submit one sample (short story, video reel, script, photography portfolio, article, etc) of what you believe to be the best example of your creative work. Should you be unable to send your sample by email, please post your work our address listed above. Note, however, that materials submitted with your application will not be returned.
